This is never easy for us after spending two years living life and growing together with them. The group of boys we've had over the past two years has been a special group for us. They had an uncommon unity, which was wonderful to see and live with. Even though they still had different interests and passions, they were very inclusive of each other and got along so well. They were such a joy for us to have, and we truly enjoyed the past six months with them as they finished out 8th grade.
